SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

- Maximum financial award amounts depend on amount of funds raised, and available for scholarships. The award is a "last dollar award", meaning it will cover the costs of tuition and fees remaining after all other scholarships and awards have been applied. Currently we are offering \$9,000 spread over 6 semesters.
